AIMS

The overall objective was to contribute to sustainable agriculture through developing advocating regeneration, conservation and of traditional agricultural enhancement landscape, as part of the overall cultural landscape.

The specific objectives were to:

- 1. Strengthening capacity of CSOs dealing with cultural heritage, landscape and agriculture so they can advocate agricultural landscape and sustainable agriculture issues;
- 2. Creating a platform of relevant stakeholders so to improve legal and institutional framework for the protection, planning and management of traditional agriculture landscape thus developing sustainable agriculture in Montenegro
- 3. Raising awareness of citizens and relevant stakeholders on importance of traditional agricultural landscape as a valuable layer of cultural landscape



RESULTS

- 1. A model for identification and analysis of traditional agricultural landscape and guidelines for the regeneration of rural and agricultural areas has been developed in a participatory manner and based on research.
- 2. Established platform of key actors in the fields of agriculture, cultural heritage, landscape and planning in Montenegro for the improvement of traditional agricultural landscape in Montenegro.
- 3. Created recommendations for improving the framework for the protection, planning and rehabilitation of traditional agricultural landscapes in Montenegro.
- 4. Research-based proposal for reviving the village and landscape of Gornja Lastva and using its potentials for sustainable agriculture have been created
- 5. Raised awareness of citizens stakeholders about traditional agricultural landscape as an important layer of cultural landscape, and about the importance of its regeneration for sustainable agriculture.
